

FIESTA BUCKHORN -- A Celebration of Fine Wine, Beer and Cuisine

Agreement by and between the BUCKHORN COMMUNITY CENTRE and NAME: (please print)

(hereafter called the "EXHIBITOR")

The Buckhorn Community Centre grants the Exhibitor the right to use exhibit space in the exhibition and to demonstrate his/her products on the following conditions:

1. The Exhibitor understands and agrees that by signing and returning this contract and receipt and processing of booth payment by March 30, 2009, a booth will be reserved for the Exhibitor's use.
2. A non-refundable booth fee of \$52.50 (\$50.00 + \$2.50 GST) payable to "Buckhorn Community Centre" will accompany this signed contract before March 30, 2009. (No post-dated cheques please.) Please remit payment and completed contract to The Buckhorn Community Centre, Box 280, Buckhorn, Ontario, K0L-1J0.
3. The Exhibitor will hold the Buckhorn Community Centre, its officers, directors employees and volunteers harmless for any and all damage, expense or liability or any injury or damage to any person, including the general public, the Exhibitor, its agents or employees or to the property of the Exhibitor out of the Exhibitor's participation in Fiesta Buckhorn.
4. The Buckhorn Community Centre will provide one or two tables and one or two tablecloths as needed, plus one chair, two returnable wineglasses and a ticket receptacle. **Exhibitors must bring their own signage. Promotional handouts are highly recommended.**
5. The Exhibitor retains 70 percent of tasting token sales. The Exhibitor agrees to provide 30 percent of tasting token sales to the Buckhorn Community Centre for its fund-raising efforts. In addition, any in-booth sales – promotional items, food, accessories – are also subject to the 30% commission to the Buckhorn Community Centre. Exhibitors are expected to provide event organizers with a summary of these sales and a cheque for 30% of sales at the time of check-out.
6. An extension cord (minimum of 25 feet) is to be provided by Exhibitor if hydro is needed. (Outlets at all booths)
7. Coolers are to be provided by Exhibitor. Each exhibitor will receive four (4) bags of ice free of charge. Additional bags will be charged at \$2 per to be deducted from exhibitor payout.
8. All booths to be set up by 11 a.m. Saturday, July 18, 2009. Take down, if required, will not start until the close of the show at 7:30 p.m. Exhibitors who run out of product prior to the end of the show will not be allowed to shut their booths until the end of the show at 7:30 p.m. **There will be a \$50 fine deducted from payout levied on exhibitors who close their booth prior to the end of the show at 7:30 p.m.**
9. Under any Special Occasion Permit allowing sale of alcohol issued by the province, a levy is payable. Expediting that levy is the responsibility of each participating winery or brewery. A copy of the Special Occasion Permit will be provided to each alcohol beverage participant upon check-in at the event.
10. The Exhibitor agrees by signing this contract that he/she accepts all the above Terms, Conditions, Rules and Regulations
